

# WELCOME TO THE SGRC

## 1 month prior to moving

- Contact the Vice President of the club
  - The VP will be able to discuss availability and move in dates
  - Due to the nature of the military slight modifications can be made if necessary, as long as there are no other horses moving in on the same day
  - Schedule facility walk through
- Send in member application
  - This application can be found at [sgrcnc.org](http://sgrcnc.org) or the VP can email you a copy.
  - We will need 2 personal references – one being from the previous boarding facility
  - Date/Time application was sent in \_\_\_\_\_

## 2 weeks out

- Contact the Secretary
  - Confirm you have sent in all of the required paperwork
    - Rules/Regulations
    - Bylaws
    - Quarantine Application
    - Member Application/Contract
    - Liability Release

### Send in updated shots/coggins/health certificate

- The health certificate is only for horses coming from out of state
- NO horse will be allowed on the property without an updated Coggins
- NO horse will be allowed in quarantine without updated shots. All shots must be administered by a veterinarian
  - Rabies
  - Eastern Equine Encephalomyelitis
  - Western Equine Encephalomyelitis
  - Equine Influenza
  - West Nile
  - Tetanus
  - Rhino pneumonitis
- Contact the Treasurer
  - Before arriving at SGRC you must have paid IN FULL – stall deposit and pro-rated board for that current month
  - Amount Owed/Day Payed \_\_\_\_\_

### Last few days

- Get Excited!
- Confirm day and timeframe of arrival with the VP
  - Confirmed Date/Time \_\_\_\_\_

We all understand that life happens and is sometimes out of our control. If you keep us in the loop, we will do our best to work with you. Being aboard MCB Camp Lejeune we do have to follow rules a bit more strictly than other barns. Though not every member at the barn agrees with all the rules, we all chose to board our horse(s) here and we have the right to move if we no longer want to follow the rules given to us. Being a self-care facility, we have found we need a bit more 'things' than usual. We have created a list of items that you will need to purchase for your horse(s) here at SGRC. You will also find a section where you can write down your assigned stall, feed, and hay areas. Pastures get assigned when your horse is coming out of quarantine
